Be a Part of National Voter Registration Day Sept. 26 with LWVTSC

Topeka, KS National Voter Registration Day is Sept. 26. Here's what the Topeka & Shawnee County League of Women Voters is doing to celebrate and highlight Americans' right and responsibility to vote.

- League voter registration committee members have helped students in the Shawnee Heights Student Government organization develop and conduct a voter registration drive during the lunch hour (11:45 a.m.-12:45 p.m.) on Sept. 26. Four Shawnee Heights students and their sponsor, Stacie Borjon, are practicing civic engagement and leadership that will benefit the Topeka Community today and in the future.
- In a collaboration between the award-winning Topeka & Shawnee County Public Library and the League, bookmobile employees trained by the League will be registering voters in addition doing their regular duties on Sept. 26. The schedule is:

- LWVTSC volunteers will be registering voters at 4 p.m. mayoral forum at the Bradbury Thompson Alumni Center on the Washburn University campus.

Any move or name change requires a voter to re-register. College students must choose to register and vote in the election in their home community or in Topeka. The League can help them with both options.

LWVTSC's goal is to increase the community's awareness of National Voter Registration Day and the fact that there are multiple locations and ways to register. Voter registration for the Nov. 7 election will close Oct. 17.
