

Your Kansas Online Voter Registration and Advance Ballot Service

We can help you register to vote, check your registration, or apply to vote by mail. To start the process, we need some information so that we can see if you are currently registered to vote in Kansas.





First, check to see whether you are registered in Kansas

To request an advance ballot or to register to vote in Kansas, we need to verify your current voter registration status.

IMPORTANT: Advance ballot requests are now available for the August primary and November general election. Please note: KSVotes.org is not processing advance ballot requests for the upcoming May presidential primary.

If you're registered to vote in Kansas you will be able to see the address where you're currently registered, your party affiliation, your polling place (if that information is currently available), the local, state and national districts you're in, and your voting history. Once you're registered, you don't need to re-register unless you change your name, residence address, or party affiliation.





If anything needs to be updated, click on "Change My Registration."




Key Registration Questions

Answer accurately.

You must be a US citizen in order to vote.

You must be 18 or older on election day in order to vote. If you will be under 18 on election day, click "No." You will not be able to vote, but your application will be held at the Election Office until your 18th birthday.






Information you put in the first page is filled here.

Already registered? If you've changed your name since you last registered, click the box







If you've changed your name since you last registered, enter your previous name.


The address you provide must be your **current residence**. Your residence address determines which ballot you will receive.





If the address in your registration record is not where you <u>currently live</u>, provide your previous residence address. That information is necessary to update your registration. Indicate a change of address even if you've only changed apartments in the same complex.


You may provide a mailing address if your mail isn't delivered to your residence.





If your address isn't found, you'll be prompted to double-check it.

Select a party: Democrat,
Republican, or Libertarian if you wish
to vote in the primary or participate
in a party caucus. If you are
"Unaffiliated" you will not be able to
vote in the August primary unless
you affiliate with Republican or
Democrat party at the election.






You will be prompted to enter your Kansas Drivers License number, the number of your nondriver ID, or the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number. If you have none of those numbers, enter "NONE" in the form.

Identification Your ID should be your drivers license #, nondrivers id card #, or the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number. ID Number Your completed voter registration form must contain your state issued driver's license number or nondriver's identification card number. If you do not have a driver's license or nondriver's identification card, you must include the last four digits of your social security number. If you do not have a driver's license or a nondriver's identification card or social security number, please write "NONE" on the form. A unique identifying number will be assigned by the State. The number you provide will be used for administrative purposes only and will not be disclosed to the public. < BACK NEXT

Sign the Application

If all the information is correct, sign in the signature box using your finger or a stylus on a touch screen. If you don't have a touch screen, you can use a mouse to sign. Use most of the space in the box. Make your signature as much like usual as possible.

Use the buttons below the signature box to make necessary changes. "Clear Signature" will allow you to try again.

Click "sign" when your signature is the way you want it.







Use the back button at the bottom of the screen if you need to change anything on your application.

Check One Last Time

Check to be sure your application will go to the county where you are a resident.

If an incorrect county is displayed, check to be sure your residential address and zip code are correct on your application.

If your address is correct on the form but the wrong county shows in this box, click "Change County" and select the correct County from the list.





It's easy to apply for a mail-in ballot online at KSVotes.org. You can apply for a ballot after completing registration. Check the deadlines to be sure you have time to request and return a mail ballot.
