While the results of the General Election are not final as we go to press with this edition of the Voter, we have a few statistics related to voter education and early voting to report from the March to the Polls activities:

Target precinct inactive voters and unregistered residents	1,125	
of those, the # that didn't vote in 2016	924	82%
of those, the # that voted early in 2020	110	12%
# reg during MTTP in target precincts	193	17%
of those, the # who voted early 2020	19	10%
Canvassed, phoned, postcards, and reached at food distribution events	2,681	(may include duplicated count of individuals)
