

## **2020 General Election Canvass**

### **Camille Nohe, Observer**

116,415 people are registered to vote in Shawnee county, historic high

86,971 people voted in the general election

19,435 people voted in person at the Election Office

23,592 mail ballots total

1,337 ballots in roving drop box

7,353 ballots in drop box across street from Election Office

3,235 ballots dropped off at Election Office

11,667 ballots received via US mail

### **Provisional ballots:**

485 name or address changes – counted

26 no ID when voting but timely cured – counted

800 mail ballot requested, then voted at polls, verified voted only once – counted

304 wrong polling place – partially counted

1 both spouses ballots in one envelope, other envelope included – counted both ballots

460 not registered – not counted (but registration card completed so can vote next time)

27 did not sign envelope, office tried to contact, unsuccessful – not counted

11 advance ballot requested and mailed back, then voted in person – advance ballot counted so provisional ballot not counted

16 – no ID when voting and did not cure – not counted

Of 71 permission to open provisional envelopes:

13 everything ok – counted

3 wrong precinct – partially counted

43 empty envelopes

12 no ID – not counted

### **Late ballots:**

13 received on Nov. 4: counted

15 received on Nov. 5: 11 of those postmarked too late so not counted & 4 counted

7 received on Nov. 6: 2 of those postmarked too late so not counted & 5 counted

14 received Nov. 7 or after

**Undeliverable ballots:** 188 mailed and returned by US Post Office, wrong address
