



To request an advance ballot or to register to vote in Kansas, we need to verify your current voter registration status.

IMPORTANT: Advance ballot requests are now available for the August primary and November general election. Please note: KSVotes.org is not processing advance ballot requests for the upcoming May presidential primary.

If you're registered to vote in Kansas you will be able to see the address where you're currently registered, your party affiliation, your polling place (if that information is currently available), the local, state and national districts you're in, and your voting history. Once you're registered, you don't need to re-register unless you change your name, residence address, or party affiliation.







If you are "Unaffiliated" you will be able to vote in the 2022 August Special election on the Constitutional amendment. You may only vote for candidates if you affiliate with Republican or Democratic party at the primary election.

Your completed voter registration form must contain your state issued driver's license number or nondriver's identification card number. If you do not have a driver's license or nondriver's identification card, you must include the last four digits of your social security number. If you do not have a driver's license or a nondriver's identification card or social security number, please write "NONE" on the form. A unique identifying number will be assigned by the State. The number you provide will be used for administrative purposes only and will not be disclosed to the public.





You will receive a card from the Election Office to let you know you are registered and where you will vote. You may vote in person at your polling place on election day, early at the county election office, OR you may apply for a mail-in ballot called an "Advance Ballot."

It's easy to apply for a mail-in ballot online at [KSVotes.org](https://ksvotes.org). You can apply for a ballot after completing registration. Check the deadlines to be sure you have time to request and return a mail ballot.

Thank you for registering to vote online through KSVotes.org. Your registration has been forwarded to your local elections official, and you should soon receive a copy of that email. If you do not receive the email, please check your spam folder.
